#### Description

Hi all,  
I'm reporting a bug about the Restore from config file of NAT Config.  
The Outbound config is "Manual Outbound NAT" and the backup/restore was not encrypted.  
The "Inbound" and "1:1" TAB import process was ok, but Outbound rules are missing, it is completely empty.  
I tried to make a new rule and then save a new Backup file.  
Into the XML there were both the new rule and the old rules, but every try to import than was unsuccessful.  
I noted that the old rules backupd from a 2.4 version, were missing two parameters  
<source\_hash\_key></source\_hash\_key>  
<ipprotocol>inet</ipprotocol>  
I tried to modify some rule, cutting them (there were 90) but I didn't solve, the restore process didn't load any rule.  
Neither the new One I made on the new 2.5 platform.  
I think that is a bug, but let you investigate.
