## Description

I have pfSense 2.0 with siproxd and noticed the following in the system log when siproxd start up is processed:

php: : Siproxd.inc -- error -- should not hit default case statement.

This comes from siproxd\_generate\_rules in siproxd.inc. I changed the line in question to print out \$type and see that it's pfearly that it's being called with. My guess is the fix is to either change the case statement to not print out that line (like other packages) or else put a case statement in for 'pfearly' which just does a break.
