#### Description

The interface selection box in the UPNP module displays the default interface names rather than the renamed interface names.

How to reproduce:

1. Rename an interface in pfSense
2. Navigate to Services ----> UPNP
3. The interface list contains the default interface names instead of the renamed interface names
