Description

Since about 29-May, php-fpm has been apparently blocking. This prevents the webgui from starting up, and also stops the boot when the line `"/usr/local/sbin/fcgicli -f /etc/rc.start_packages"` is executed in `/etc/rc`. Killing and restarting the php-fpm process will get things going again, temporarily, until it blocks again.

May also be causing problems with `check_reload_status` taking 100% CPU.

Please ask if you need more details, but it's easily reproducible in any snapshot in the last 4 days or so.
