Description

Using "2.2-ALPHA (amd64) built on Fri Aug 15 14:31:24 CDT 2014".

Simple "High Avail. Sync" setup with two CARP IPs, one for WAN and another for LAN. I'm unable to change already created CARP IPs. Even just changing the description of a CARP IP, I get the following validation error:

From the error message, could it be that it's trying to create a new CARP IP, instead of changing the existing one?

Fix #3807:

- When changing a pre existing VIP, use previous configured interface for checking, this fixes the issue that happens when you try to change a VIP to a new interface.
- Use the right interface name, only carp uses _vipN suffix
