**Description**

Upon initially filling in the fields appropriately on system\_usermanager\_settings.php for LDAP, and clicking the Select button next to "LDAP Authentication container", you get:

```
Sorry, we could not connect to the LDAP server. Please try later.
```

It works when clicking Select after clicking Save, but not before those settings are saved. It should work before it's saved as well.
