Description

Hello,

- Created two bandwidth limiters "OutLimit" and "InLimit".
- Selected then as In/Out in a firewall WAN rule
- Went to shaper and renamed the limiters to "LimitOut" and "LimitIn"
- Went to firewall WAN rule - limiters are not selected, shows None/None.

Suggestion: renaming limiters should not remove them from firewall rules where they are used. I didn't test with other traffic shaper item types, same issue could be there as well.
