### Enabling Unity plugin adds garbage to the last domain name

<b>Description</b> <p>If the Unity plugin is enabled, garbage is added to the last domain listed in Split DNS. In my case, it's always the character 'p'.</p> <p>For instance, if the Split DNS entry is "mydomain.com", then strongSwan will send a domain of "mydomain.comp". If the Split DNS entry is "mydomain.com bogus", then strongSwan will send domains of "mydomain.com" and "bogusp".</p> <p>You can see this by setting the Message encoding debug level to "highest" and looking at the generated packets.</p> <p>Note that the garbage does not appear in /var/etc/strongswan.conf, so I presume this to be an upstream defect.</p>
