pkg_mgr_install has a js counter function that does a windows.location("/index.php") after 90 seconds. if pfSense hasn't booted after 90 seconds, the browser will eventually get a "problem loading page"....

I've created a PR for this, which works, but has room for improvement. (js & ajax make my stomach hurt)
