Attempting to change the charset to anything just render the error:  
"The following input errors were detected:  
Need at least 2 characters to create vouchers."

Example:  
"ABCDEFGHIJKLMNOPQRSTUVWXYZ"

```
if ($_POST['charset'] && (strlen($_POST['charset'] < 2))) {
```

This causes the system to only allow digits in the voucher charset dialog.

Correct line should be:

```
if ($_POST['charset'] && (strlen($_POST['charset']) < 2)) {
```
