<p>The default setting was triggering "SURICATA HTTP request field too long" alerts (apparently changed to "SURICATA HTTP request buffer too long" in suricata 3.1.2). I was able to change this manually by editing /usr/local/pkg/suricata/suricata_yaml_template.inc and adding it directly:</p>			
<pre># Configure libhttp. libhttp: default-config: {\$http_hosts_default_policy} meta-field-limit: 30000</pre>
