#### Description

vpn\_i2tp\_configure in /etc/inc/vpn.inc has killbypid and sleep(8) even if starting it for first time. I suggest it should check if file\_exists() first. Note that killbypid via sigkillbypid does check for that but wrap both with it since the sleep(8) is done regardless.

(I noticed this while working on my book.
