**Description**

Any changes to the barnyard configuration page requires that you update the password as well, otherwise \*\* is written to your configuration and stopping barnyard2 from working properly. I suggest making the password field mandatory on this configuration screen.

Repro steps:

Navigate to: [https://pfsense/snort/snort\\_barnyard.php?id=0](https://pfsense/snort/snort_barnyard.php?id=0), hit save, and inspect the newly written baryard2.conf file you will see something like:

```

Those \*\*\* are where the password should be, that isn't me censoring this bug.
