Please add "local-as" feature in OpenBGPD webgui "neighbors" tab -> "Neighbor Parameters". This command is described here - <a href="http://man.openbsd.org/bgpd.conf#local-as">http://man.openbsd.org/bgpd.conf#local-as</a>			
One note - every <u>global config</u> openbgpd command documented in its man is possible to be used via "raw config". But if I add a documented <u>bgp neighbor context</u> command which is not present via webgui - for example, this one - <a href="http://man.openbsd.org/bgpd.conf#log_no">http://man.openbsd.org/bgpd.conf#log_no</a> - bgpd considers it to be a "syntax error"
